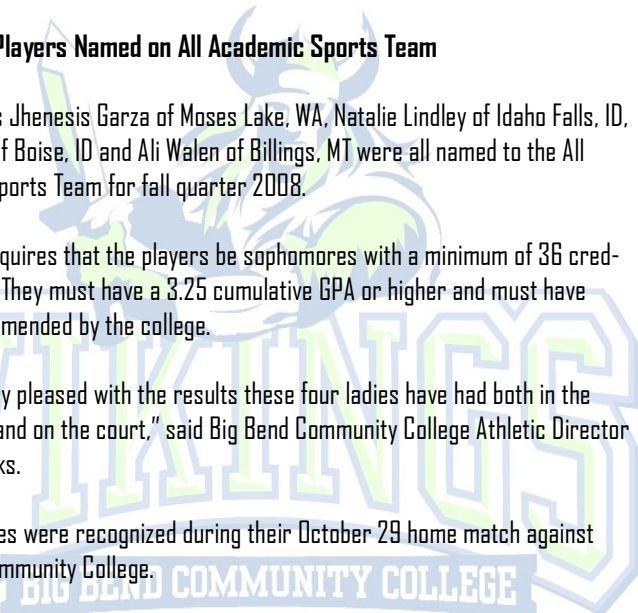
Volleyball Players Named on All Academic Sports Team
